



Aloha Challenge Qualifier



We have been awarded one of the coveted spots to the 2020 Aloha Challenge. What is the Aloha Challenge? It is a one day tournament that will take place on February 22, 2020 in Oahu, Hawaii, exclusively for active APA members. We will be having a qualifying tournament on Sept 28-29 to raise travel funds and determine the lucky team that will get to attend this event. Suggested travel dates are Feb 20-26 to get the best travel rates. Here are the details

Format is 8 Ball, round robin. 8 person teams. Teams may be made up of any combination of active OPAL/APA players who meet the requirements. Each player must have an 8 ball skill level based on a minimum of 10 scores and must be on an active Fall session team (any format). Exceptions: Players who play 9 ball only will play at their 9 ball skill level plus 1. Players who play Masters only, will play as a skill level 7. 23 rule is in effect. Maximum field: 32 teams. Play on Saturday will be split between Wichita Town Pub, 6106 King Rd, Milwaukie and Midway, 1003 7th St, Oregon City. All play on Sunday will be at Wichita Town Pub Start time both days 9 am

We will be playing the qualifier using the same format as the tournament in Hawaii. Teams will be split into four 8 team flights. You will play each team in your flight to collect team points. 5 points will be available for each round. At the beginning of the match, each team will select their 5 person team who will play that round, from the highest skill level to the lowest skill level. The 5 players selected for the round must add up to 23 or less. The two highest players on each team will then play each other one game for one point, then the next two highest players play one game for one point and so on, until all 5 players selected for that round have played. Each player on your roster must play a minimum of 3 times by the end of 7 rounds. There is no coaching allowed. At the end of 7 rounds, the two teams that have accumulated the most points from each flight will advance to the playoffs on Sunday. Ties will be broken in accordance with the rules listed in the Official Team Manual, on page 36.

100% of the entry fees collected from this qualifier (minus greens fees) will go to the team advancing to Hawaii to assist with their travel arrangements.

Aloha Challenge Entry Form: Entry fee is \$400 per team. \$200 deposit must accompany this entry form to hold your spot. Remaining \$200 must be paid by September 15, 2019 All roster changes must be to us by September 24, 2019 Entries are limited to the first 32 registered teams
