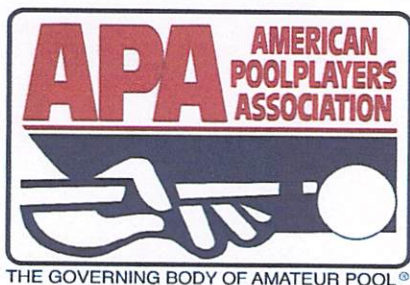

For this event, you must be on an active APA team (8 ball, 9 ball, Masters, Ladies or Doubles) You must have a skill level based on at least 10 scores. 10 scores must have been earned in the last 2 years. Open 8 ball players who have never played 9 ball or have not played Open 9 ball in over a year, will have their skill levels determined by the tournament director. Master players that have never played on an Open 8 ball or Open 9 ball team or have not played on an open team in over a year will play as a skill level 9. No timeouts or coaching allowed. 100% of the entry fees, minus the greens fee, will be paid out to the top 25% of the field in each bracket. Number of entries in each skill level will determine how the brackets will be set up and how many brackets for each skill level we will have. Optimum would be at least one bracket for each skill level. The more entries we have, the more brackets we can create. Format will be modified single elimination.

Blind Draw scotch doubles, Race to 2, Modified single elimination, APA rules

Entry fee \$5

Format is Fast 8-4 stripes and 4 solids, racked like 9 ball with the 8 ball in the middle. Rules: Lag for the break, players alternate shots starting with the first break. Rotation continues throughout the entire race. If your partner pockets the 8 ball, you will break the next rack. There are no timeouts or coaching, During the course of the race, play will be stopped by the Master Of The Universe at least once. While play is stopped, the Master Of The Universe will announce the fate that the Pool Gods and Goddesses will bestow upon you.

Here are examples of some of the things that the Master Of The Universe may use. These, any combination of these or whatever pops into the head of the Master Of The may be used.

1. Current shot must be taken "monkey on your back style)
2. Current shooter must take the next shot using the butt of their cue
3. Current shooter must take next shot blindfolded.
4. Pool God will randomly pick up any ball on the table and place it in the pocket.
5. Pool God will place a marker next to the pocket that the 8 ball must legally be pocketed to win the current game.
6. Switch shooters

In addition, the Pool Gods and Goddesses may put obstacles on the table, get in your line of sight or do other things to distract you.

Everyone must keep their clothes on and the Master Of The Universe may not instruct you to do something that is dangerous or may cause harm to the pool tables.

The whole point of this tournament is to have fun and not take things too seriously. Relax and enjoy yourselves.
