NUMBER OF TIMES YOU MUST PLAY

In order to advance to playoffs and tri-cups, you must play at least 4 times with your team this session. In double jeopardy, you must play 4 times with the 8-ball team to advance with the 8-ball team. In order to advance with the 9-ball team, you must play 4 times with the 9-ball team.

NEW PLAYERS AND THEIR SKILL LEVELS

As with every session, we have many new members in the league this session. Anyone with a membership number of 18800 or higher is new to the league. Please be aware that these new players will bounce around the whole skill level range until they get 6 or 7 scores in. We don't mind comments about these new players such as "has good cue ball control" or "good ball selection" but calling these players sandbaggers at this stage in the session does not even make sense. I dare to say that 90% of you did not start at the proper skill level or get there within the first few weeks. Give these new players a chance to get their scores in before assuming that they are purposely keeping their skill levels below what they should be. It is very rare that a player goes straight to their true skill level after only a couple of plays.

All Membership Dues Must be Paid this Week

All membership dues must be paid this week or players will be dropped from the roster, even if they have not played yet this session and even if you are not scheduled to play this week. We get fined \$45 per person from headquarters, if we allow anyone to play without paying their dues. We are not willing to absorb this penalty. Players must pay their dues on the first team they play on this week. The membership dues must be paid to the captain and captains need to get their envelopes in on time to keep from losing players. Captains, please make sure that everyone has paid and turned in a membership application.

Opposing teams, it is <u>not your responsibility</u> to make sure that the other team has all members paid. Many players play on more than one night, and may have paid their dues, but it hasn't caught up with your score sheet yet. Play the match as normal and we will determine in the office if a player has been played illegally and award points as necessary.

Only 2 Senior Skill Levels May Play in a 9-Ball Match Senior Skill Levels are 6 and Above

23 RULE

Breaking the 23 rule is absolutely forbidden. The skill levels of the players that play must add up to 23 or less. The 23 rule must be met even if all 5 races are not played. You cannot play 4 races to 23 and forfeit the 5th race. You must be able to prove had all 5 races been played, that you could have stayed at 23 or less with the line up that you play. For the Super divisions the cap is 26. Masters divisions do not have a skill level cap.
