UNSCORED MATCHES

You may find that some or in some cases all of the matches were not scored from last week. The reason is that one or both captains failed to get in member dues or complete applications from some of their players. Any one who pays the old fashioned way, must completely fill out a new member application each and every year. If they do not want to do the paperwork, then please ask them to pay online at www.poolplayers.com. We cannot score matches with unpaid players and we cannot not mark those players paid until we receive their complete applications. Those of you that did everything correctly, you are not being penalized. We will score the matches as soon as we can mark those players paid and you will receive all points earned for that match. Those of you that receive notes from us about those unpaid players, please get their complete applications and/or dues in this week so we can get everyone caught up.

QUALIFIED TEAMS-PLEASE READ!

Teams that have already qualified for regionals or those who will become qualified in the upcoming tri-cups, please read pages 85-95 of the Official Team Manual to make sure that you understand what it takes to keep your team eligible. Basically, you only have until week 4 to make any changes to your roster. The players that you have on your roster at the flip of the coin on week 4 will be the players that will advance to regionals with your team. No changes can be made to your team after week 4. Each member of your team must play a minimum of 4 times with your team this session, before playoffs and/or tri cups, or they will be dropped from your regional team. All players must have a skill level based on a minimum of 10 scores in the format that you are advancing in. The 10 scores must have been earned in the last 2 years. If you are adding a brand new player or one that is converting from one format to another, or someone who has not played in the last 2 years, they must play a minimum of 10 matches during this session. If you have a question as to the number of scores required for each player, please contact me so I can give you the specifics. Do not rely on information that you get from other players. I would hate to have a player or team get disqualified because they were misinformed (it happens every year). Boomer is the only one that can give you the information that you need. Regionals only happens once a year and league members get confused with the rules from other events. Please use email whenever possible so you have it in writing: apaboomer@aol.com.
