

## **\$\$\$ NEXT TO A PLAYER'S NAME**

\$\$\$ next to a player's name means that player owes us money. It could be from a returned check or money owed from a previous session. That money needs to be paid or that person will not be allowed to play in playoffs or tri-cups and may not be allowed to return next session. Encourage your players to call the office to make arrangements to get this taken care of.

## Number of Times You Must Play

In order to participate with your team in playoffs or tri-cups, a player must have played with your team a minimum of 4 times in the format you are advancing in. Double jeopardy teams, that means 4 times in 8-ball to go to 8-ball playoffs/tri-cups and 4 times in 9-ball to go to 9-ball playoffs/tri-cups. Forfeits and byes do not count as a match played.

### MAKEUP MATCHES

Make up matches must be completed by November 15. If you are planning to attend Chinook Winds, make arrangements now with the opposing team to <u>pre-play</u> that match. If you have players that will be gone the week of Thanksgiving, make arrangements now with the opposing team to <u>pre-play that match.</u> When teams fail to complete make up matches, it affects the entire division and there are heavy penalties for not completing these matches. It is up to both teams to work together to get these matches completed. Once you have decided on a date and a time to get your make up matches completed, let us know. That way if a team no shows, you are covered. If you are having trouble coming to an agreement, let us know. We will work with both teams to come to a common ground and if we have to we will set the date, which could hurt both teams. We would rather that the two teams come to an agreement on their own.

### Pay Your 2015 Member Dues online

Avoid the hassle, budget your money and pay your 2015 member dues online at poolplayers.com with your credit or debit card. Be sure and make any changes to your address and phone number while there, because starting in January, your member packet will be sent directly to the address listed on your profile. Be sure and include an apartment number, if applicable and your zip code. Anyone who paid their 2014 member dues after August 15 will only owe \$15 as long as they pay their 2015 dues by March 1, 2015. Anyone who received a complementary membership for 2014, will owe the entire \$25 for 2015. Remember, all players must pay their member dues on or before the first night of play. Pay your member dues online by January 5, 2015 and you will be put in a drawing for \$8 free play certificates. *If you have new players that will not be playing in 2014, but will start in 2015, tell them not to pay their dues until after December 1, 2014. Otherwise, they will get charged for 2014 and then owe again for 2015. Approximately 33% of our members paid their dues online for 2014. We would like to see at least 50% for 2015.*
