Once qualified, you must remain on an active team in the format that you qualify in through Spring session. Regionals will be the last weekend in February. Nationals will be the first week in May. Play Till You Win-play on as many 4 person single elimination boards as it takes to get qualified or we run out of time. Entry fee is \$40, plus \$3 greens fee per person. You must pre-register! We need at least 30 players for each day, pre-registered by November 23, to make these worth while. Boards will be split by skill level whenever possible.
