### Team Fees Are Now \$40

It has been 8 years since we have raised the team fees and we have held off longer than we should have. In order to provide the service that you have come to expect, we are forced to raise the team fees to cover the rising costs of doing business and funding the benefits that we in place for you. Team fees are now \$40 or \$8 per person. Double Jeopardy is a combined total of \$80. Masters remain at \$30.

### What Is To Be Announced?

To Be Announced means that we have an odd number of teams in the division. These are not byes. We have the first 4 weeks of the session to get those spots filled. For now, if you are scheduled for the To Be Announced, we do not have a team for you to play this week. If we do get a team in for you to play, we will notify you by 5 pm the day before your night of play. If you do not hear from us by that time, assume that you are not playing that week. If we do end up filling that position, you will have a makeup to complete. If we do not fill that position by week 5, that will become a bye and all bye points will be awarded at that time.

### Member Dues Must Be Paid On First Night of Play

Anyone who has not paid their 2014 member dues, must do so on or before the first night of play. Member dues can be paid online at [poolplayer.com](http://poolplayer.com). If the member chooses to pay the captain on the first night of play, they must also completely fill out a membership application. The complete membership application and \$25 member dues must come in together by processing day. Failure to get this completed will result in matches not getting scored and/or possible loss of points. Have your new members fill out the application and turn in the member dues before you play them.

### Expect Schedule Changes

Schedule changes are to be expected in the first few weeks of any session. We have teams that are coming in and some teams that are falling apart. Please check the web site for changes and make sure you open your packets immediately so you can let your teammates know where they need to be.
