Number of Times You Must Play

In order to participate with your team in playoffs or tri-cups, a player must have played with your team a minimum of 4 times in the format you are advancing in. Double jeopardy teams, that means 4 times in 8-ball to go to 8-ball playoffs/tri-cups and 4 times in 9-ball to go to 9-ball playoffs/tri-cups. Forfeits and byes do not count as a match played. This is a really short session, so get everyone's match in as soon as possible.

US Amateur Entry Deadline Approaching

US Amateur entries must be postmarked by June 15. Do not send them to us. They need to go directly to headquarters, whose address is listed on the entry form. The preliminary round will be held at The Cueball, in Salem on September 26, 2015. You may also go to poolplayers.com, "Tournament Information", "US Amateur Championships" and sign up and pay online. No late entries will be accepted.

Saturday, Sunday and Monday Divisions

This is Memorial Day Weekend. If you cannot field a team on your regular schedule day to play, you need to contact the opposing team to schedule a makeup. Notify the office by email or phone to let us know that you will not be playing this week, we will give you the opposing captain's phone number. Also contact the location that is scheduled to host your match to let them know that you will not be playing this week. You will have approximately 5 weeks to get that makeup match completed and into the office.
