Team Fees Are Now \$40

It has been 8 years since we have raised the team fees and we have held off longer than we should have. In order to provide the service that you have come to expect, we are forced to raise the team fees to cover the rising costs of doing business and funding the benefits that we in place for you. Team fees are now \$40 or \$8 per person. Double Jeopardy is a combined total of \$80. Masters remain at \$30. Ladies Division team fees are \$24.

In order to collect the free memberships, you must submit a completed membership application for the new players that are to benefit along with the registration form. No more than two free memberships per team. Good while supplies last, first come, first served. **In addition, the person who puts in the new team will be put into a special drawing for a room and airfare (5 days, 4 nights) to attend the 2015 National tournament next August, For every 10 "new" teams that come in between now and week 4, we will draw one winner at the next session end party, January 4, 2015.** Good Luck and good recruiting.

If we do end up filling that position, you will have a makeup to complete. If we do not fill that position by week 5, that will become a bye and all bye points will be awarded at that time.
