Number of Times You Must Play

In order to participate with your team in playoffs or tri-cups, a player must have played with your team a minimum of 4 times in the format you are advancing in. Double jeopardy teams, that means 4 times in 8-ball to go to 8-ball playoffs/tri-cups and 4 times in 9-ball to go to 9-ball playoffs/tri-cups. Forfeits and byes do not count as a match played.

Attention All Divisions Except Thursday

We do not have league scheduled for Thanksgiving day, however, we do have league scheduled for Thanksgiving week. Check with your team mates to see if they will be available to play that week. If you cannot field a team, please contact the opposing team and make arrangements to pre-play that match. The same holds true for Chinook Winds week. If you cannot field a team for that week, make arrangements to get it pre-played and out of the way. Do not wait until the last minute. Failure to complete all scheduled matches will result in your team becoming ineligible for wild card, playoffs and/or tri-cups no matter what position you hold in the standings.

To make the change, write the new name next to your old one on the score sheet. Double Jeopardy teams, you need to make the change on both score sheets.

Missing Points?

If you are missing team points after last week's match, it is most likely because there is a non paid member either on your team or the opposing team. In order to mark a player paid, we must have a complete application from them, even if they are a former member. We are required to keep our database up-to-date. The way to avoid this is to get your teammates to pay their member dues online at poolplayers.com. Saves both of us the hassle of trying to collect those paper membership forms. All matches will be caught up as soon as we get what we need to get those unpaid members marked paid. No one has been penalized at this point, we just cannot score those matches. Along this same line, if your address or phone number has changed, please go to poolplayers.com and update it. Please make sure that your primary phone number is entered into the slot marked "home" and that your complete address, including apt #, is entered in the slot marked "address 1" to avoid a * showing up next to your name.

Please make sure that the Captain of your team is listed first on your roster and the Co-captain is listed 2nd. Any changes need to be indicated on your score sheet (s). Only the players that are listed first and second on your roster will be invited to the capt/co-capt tournament at the end of the session. Double jeopardy teams may have a captain and co-captain for 8 ball and a different captain and/or co-captain for 9 Ball
