In order to participate, you must be on an active 9-ball team and have a 9-ball skill level based on a minimum of 10 scores. Once qualified for regionals, you must remain on an active 9-Ball team. All skill levels are invited. Boards will be grouped by skill level whenever possible.

Sunday, March 18, 9-Ball starting at 10 am KC’s Midway
Saturday, March 24, 9-Ball starting at 10 am KC’s Midway
Sunday, March 25, 9-Ball starting at 10 am Rodder’s
