September 28-30th KC's Midway, and Rodders in Oregon City graciously co-hosted our OPAL-APA Fall Session 8-Ball Tri-Cup. Both locations and their crews did a fantastic job as hosts. The food and drink service were excel-

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lent and the sites accommodated our event extremely well and all the pool players and guests had a great time throughout the weekend. This event even turned out to be extra-special for Boomer, and Myself, because we received several positive compliments from many of the teams and players this past weekend.

We had exactly 43 division 8-Ball finalists teams competing in the Modified Single elimination format,— guaranteeing that all teams got to play twice, but not necessarily lose twice. It was a weekend of close competition with the majority of all team matches going right down to double hill in deciding the winner. Once a team reached three match race wins though the match was declared over.

We had a payout of \$14,244 which was dispersed throughout the entire field. One round was conducted on Friday night, three rounds on Saturday, and concluded on Sunday at the Midway with for rounds finishing up about 7:45 PM. The results are as follows:

FINISHING 1ST and winning the bragging rights—the coveted Platinum Medallions— and the top money prize of \$1,494—from the Northern Double Jeopardy division was Back Alley's "The Ravens with Team Captain Jonathan "Windex" Hahn, and teammates: Helen Hecimovich-Hahn, Brian Newcomb, Anthony Bittner, Brett Usher, Lindy Taylor, and Daniel Olson II.

"Double O.C.'s" journey to the finals was all the way straight forward and undefeated, but certainly not without peril, nor certainly without panic and underwear changes either. They started out at the Rodders on Friday Night by plucking the feather's off of "The Raven's" alter ego "The Bald Eagles" and booting them to the one loss side. Then, the next morning they flattened "Why So Hard?" 3-1 and forced them to fast wing it over to the one loss side as well. The "<u>Ravens</u>" had a much longer journey to the finals. then did the "<u>OC's!</u>" The Blackbirds started out Friday night at the Midway by getting dog-boned to the one-loss side 2-3 by the "<u>Puppy Patrol.</u>" Returning at 1: PM the next day, "<u>The Ravens</u>" let the water out of the "<u>Underground Shark Tank</u>" 3-Zip to move to the 5:PM round. There they avoided double sudden death by 3-Zipping and sending Mousetrap's "<u>Let's Pool Around</u>" out the door to home while "<u>The Ravens</u>" made plans to head on into Sunday's Medal round.

In Sunday's 9-Am Bridesmaid / Bronze round "<u>The Ravens</u>" detonated the "<u>O.C. After a color of money break on 5 simultaneous match tables the final competition began and the results ensued as follows:

On Table 1, Raven's SL-6 *Daniel Olson* was playing against OC's SL-5 *Josh Farris*. The match was tied with 2 games to go, but did not finish.

On Table 2, Raven's SL-3 *Lindy Taylor* wiped out "OC"s" SL-3 *Linda Johnson* 2-zip. Score 1 Zip so far in favor of the Ravens.

On Table 3, Raven's SL-7 *Jonathan "Windex" Hahn* conquered OC's SL-5 *Ron Farris* 5-1. to take the race. Score 2-zip in favor of the Ravens.

On Table 4, Raven's SL-4 **Brian Newcomb** was tied double hill 2-2 with OC's SL-4 **Kyle Davis** but they did not finish.

On Table 6 Raven's SL-3 *Helen Hahn* was matched up against OC's SL-3 *Janet Farris*. Janet won the lag and the first game and put herself on the hill. Helen won the 2nd game to bring the match to double hill. In the case game both had their chances but it was *Helen* who brought it home to win the game, the match, and to claim for her team the prestigious Platinum Star Medallions, all the bragging rights, and the crown of: *Summer Session 2012 8-Ball Tri-Cup Champions*.

The next step will be the June 14-16, 2013 8-Ball Regionals where all of the pictured winners will compete along with the other worthy finalists from both the Fall and Spring 8-Ball Tri-Cups. We probably will have seven slots allocated to us for the APA National 8-Ball Team Championship at the Riviera Hotel & Casino in Las Vegas Nevada, August 22-26, 2013.
