

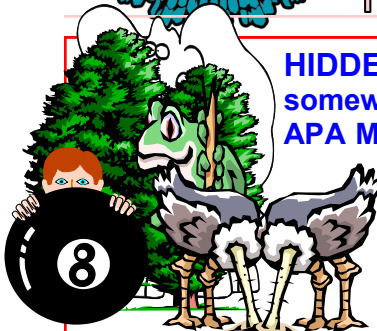

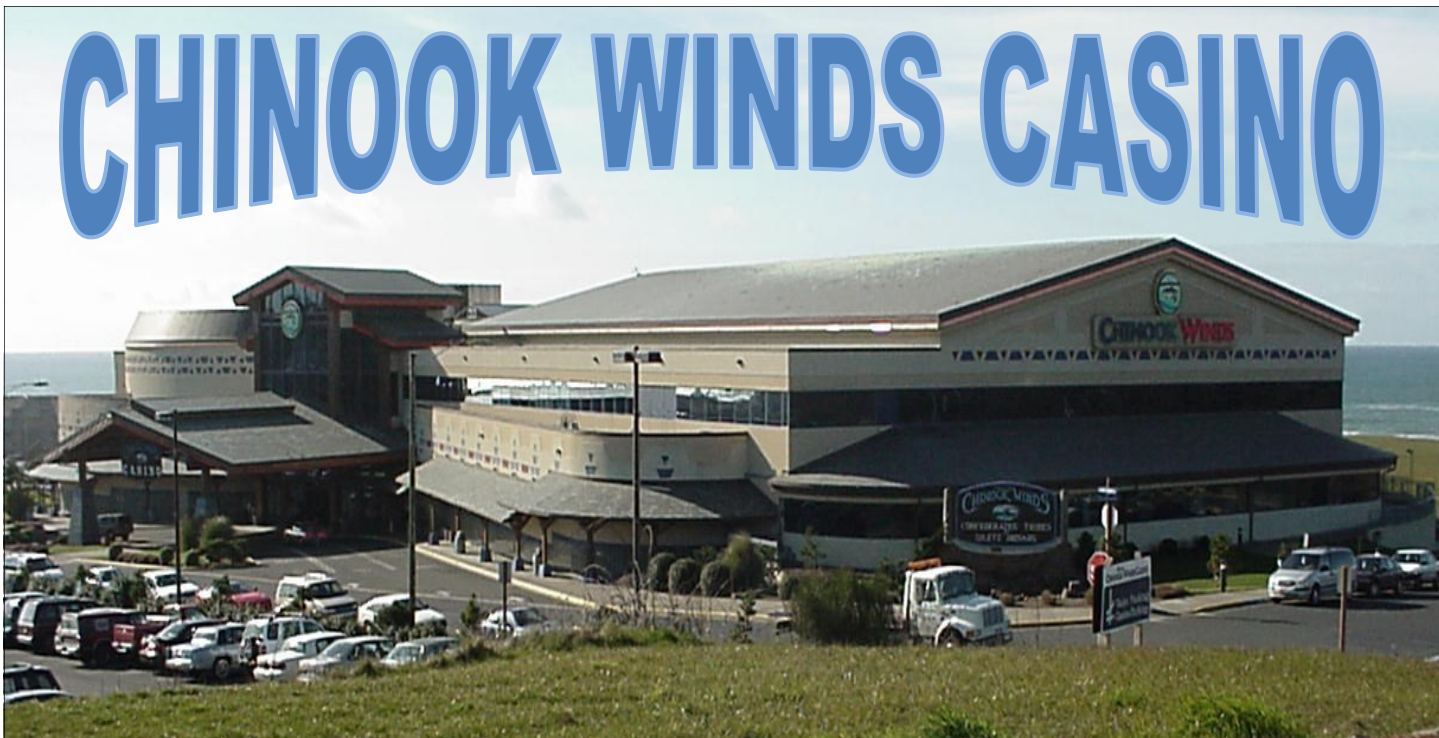

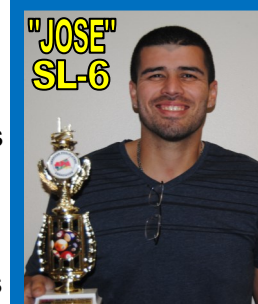


In the Skill Level 6 Category we had 18 participants and paid out to the top 4 places.

## THE LINCOLN CITY OPEN

40 players competed in the \$25 entry "Lincoln City Open"—a double elimination single's event directed by "Billiards and Barstools." There was a \$1,000 purse which was paid out to the top eight finishers. The grueling race to 7 competition on both sides got underway right after the 1 PM Saturday afternoon deadline.

There were a lot of people spectating this event with interest due to the strong known player field. The competitors enjoyed a race to seven on both sides of the bracket. **Mike Grimm** went all the way to the final's undefeated and waited to see who would emerge from the back side to challenge him. **Bob Zack** made it to the quarter finals before getting kicked to the one loss side by **Paul Marquez**. In the backside **Bobby** took down **Randy Baker** in a double hill thriller, then revenged himself against **Paul Marquez** and head to the finals against **Mike Grimm** who he would have to beat in two consecutive races to claim the victory—which is what happened. The final results were as follows:

**Bobby Zack** won the bragging rights and the first place money of \$300. **Mike Grimm** got 2nd and \$200. **Paul Marquez** claimed 3rd and \$150. **Randy Baker** took 4th and \$100. **Steve Lingelbach** and **Steve Register** both got \$75 each for 5th & 6th places, and lastly **Kris Derby** and **Fred Joseph** came in on the caboose at 7th and 8th with \$50 each.

# 3-PERSON TEAM EVENT

Starting on Friday Morning after the player's meeting we entered into the round robin phase of the 3 person team competition. There were 116 teams entered which were broken down into two flights. There were 29 boards of four teams. Half played in the first round, and the other half had a two hour break. Then the other half played allowing the first half to take a two hour break. That's how it went throughout the day and into the evening. When the Round Robin portion Concluded the two top teams in each board plus 7 wild card teams drawn from the 3 place finishers would go on to compete in a Modified Single Elimination 64 board on Saturday morning. Play continued all through Saturday and again Sunday morning to complete the Quarter, the Semi, and then the Final match rounds which ended at 4 PM on Sunday afternoon. For brevity purposes, we just listed just the top 24 finishing teams on the table to the right. →

IN THE BEAT THE MERLE CONTEST...Merle, took on any and all challengers playing a total of 360 racks of 9-Ball from Thursday Noon through the draw time on Sunday. After a slow start of losing 4 of his first 9 games, Merle eventually lucked out 226 wins and 134 losses—about a 65+% win average. (there were only three 9-Ball Breaks and three Break 'n Runs. Getting the first 5 ticket break and run was OPAL's very own Tyson Croonquist. Then, along came Salem's Dwayne Larsen about 130 games later, Then not to get out done along came OPAL's Steve Register about a hundred games after that.

The contest rules were simple. \$5. would get challengers 3 games of 9-Ball. They always racked and broke their own rack. If they won the game they got a chance at winning a cue. The prizes were a collectors dream "Camel Joe" embroidered denim jacket, a heavy duty APA coat, a nice McDermott playing cue, A Cue Tec Break stick, and a Lucasi Jump Cue. If the Challenger Broke 'n Ran they got 5 tickets. If they snapped the 9 off on the break they got 3 tickets. If they beat Merle they got two tickets and if they "cheesed" the 9 early they received 1 ticket .

Winning the McDermott playing cue by the skillful drawing fingers of people who were close by the podium at the time of the draw—was OPAL's Terak Zaher. Winning the Cue Tec breaking cue was Seattle's Daniel Sie. 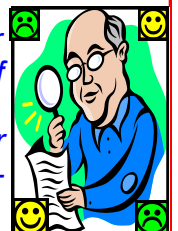
