

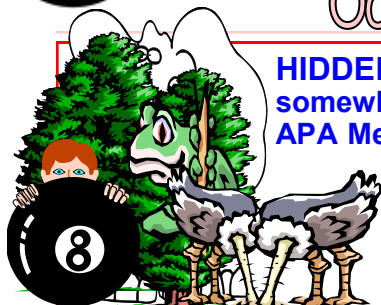

It has proven to be the perfect get-away where you can relax and enjoy that which most of you cherish the most—playing pool while in the casual company of your friends and loved ones—and, of course, the opportunity to "Beat The Merle," and probably a chance to win a prize.

On Thursday we'll kicking off at 9 AM with our combined Skill Level 11 and below, 9-Ball Early Bird

Scotch doubles event.
