For 27 consecutive years, our players have met and played out APA races to earn match points for either the North or the South. The tally in the series is currently 16-11 in favor of the South. All active APA players of all skill levels are invited to participate in this popular event. All play will be at Legends.

Format: Singles, 9 Ball, Double Elimination. The first round, players are matched up North vrs South. Each time this match up occurs during the course of the tournament, whoever wins the race will earn a point for their side. In addition, each pre-paid entrant will receive a commemorative t-shirt. 100% payout (minus green fees) will be paid out to the top 33% of the field. The first 48 paid entries for each area will be guaranteed a slot in the tournament and a t-shirt in their size. In order to participate, you must be an active APA member on an active team (any format) and must have a skill level based on at least 10 scores. 8 Ball players who do not have a 9 ball skill level or have not played 9 ball in the last two years will be assigned a 9 ball skill level for this tournament based on their 8 ball skill level. Entry fee is \$40 per player (includes green fees). This event fills up very quickly, so don't delay. Entry deadline is March 6, 2024. The field is strictly limited to 96 total players.
